

At a glance...

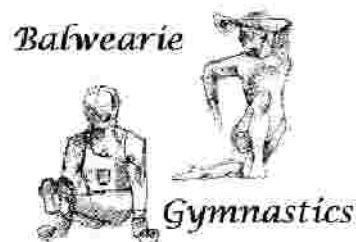
Balwearie Gymnastics is one of the largest clubs in Scotland.

Recreational Gymnastics

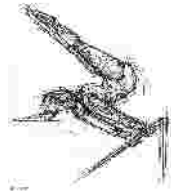
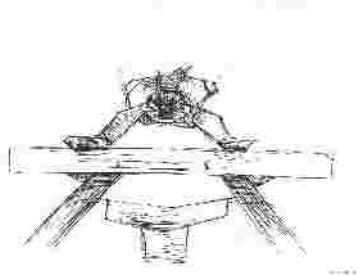
Competitive gymnastics

The Club is affiliated to the British Gymnastics Association and the Scottish Gymnastics Association.

Is is a satellite club within the Fife Gymnastics Network and a member of the Kirkcaldy Area Sports Council.



Balwearie Gymnastics uses various award schemes during class time.

All Children begin by working on basic proficiency award if a child shows particular ability he or she will be given the chance to attend extra classes and, if able to do so, progress to full competition gymnastics.

Fully qualified club coaches and assistant coaches teach all children. The club offers opportunities for ex-gymnasts, parents or guardians to learn to teach gymnastics and welcome anyone who wishes to do so. All teaching personnel participate in the BGA coach education programme.

The club is responsible for all running costs and purchase of specialist equipment.

Although the club receives grant aid from Fife Council and Sport Tayside & Fife, class fees and fund raising events are necessary to cover most of the clubs costs.

How to join...

Balwearie Gymnastics operates a waiting list system for class entry.

To be put on the waiting list contact should be made with the club administrator. Refer Overleaf.

Children on the waiting list will be offered a place in a beginner's class when a suitable vacancy becomes available.

Once a child is invited to join the club he/she will be expected to register with SGA at a fee required by the Association. This is currently £20 per year for non-competitive gymnasts.

Class fees require to be paid on a monthly basis by standing order.

Class fees for a 1 hour class are currently £17.10 per month.

Fees are reviewed each year.
